




RELATIVE SPECTRAL POWER DISTRIBUTION




RELATIVE FLUX VS. JUNCTION TEMPERATURE




ELECTRICAL CHARACTERISTICS ($T_J = 85$ °C)









RELATIVE FLUX VS. CURRENT (T_J = 85 °C)








RELATIVE CHROMATICITY VS CURRENT (WARM WHITE)









RELATIVE CHROMATICITY VS TEMPERATURE (WARM WHITE)

TYPICAL SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION








THERMAL DESIGN

The maximum forward current is determined by the thermal resistance between the LED junction and ambient. It is crucial for the end product to be designed in a manner that minimizes the thermal resistance from the solder point to ambient in order to optimize lamp life and optical characteristics.



STANDARD WHITE CHROMATICITY REGIONS PLOTTED ON THE CIE 1931 CURVE




STANDARD WHITE CHROMATICITY REGIONS PLOTTED ON THE CIE 1931 CURVE - CONTINUED




STANDARD WHITE CHROMATICITY REGIONS PLOTTED ON THE CIE 1931 CURVE - CONTINUED




STANDARD WARM AND NEUTRAL WHITE KITS PLOTTED ON ANSI STANDARD CHROMATICITY REGIONS






REFLOW SOLDERING CHARACTERISTICS

Cree LED recommends keeping XLamp LEDs in the provided, resealable moisture-barrier packaging (MBP) until immediately prior to soldering. Unopened MBPs that contain XLamp LEDs do not need special storage for moisture sensitivity.

Once the MBP is opened, XLamp XHP70.2 LEDs may be stored as MSL 1 per JEDEC J-STD-033, meaning they have unlimited floor life in conditions of \leq 30 °C/85% relative humidity (RH). Regardless of the storage condition, Cree LED recommends sealing any unsoldered LEDs in the original MBP.


Recommended PCB Solder Pad 6 V Configuration (thermal pad is electrically isolated)




Recommended PCB Solder Pad 12 V Configuration (thermal pad is connected to anode and cathode and is not electrically isolated)




Recommended Solder Pad (Solder Resist Pattern) 6 V & 12 V Configurations (solid area is open)





